


Symmetric Window Decoration




You think your windows could use a little paint? Then make your new symmetrical decoration! Whether you want to invest little or a lot of effort - the result will always look beautiful!

You'll need scissors and square paper. This can be white or coloured and it is not important, how big the square is. Just pick the one you find.

1. Put the square in front of you and fold it once diagonally so that you get a triangle:



2. Then fold the triangle twice so that you cut the long side in half and the corners with the acute angles come to rest on each other:



3. You now have a triangle of paper in your hand, which is eight-ply. On one edge it cannot be opened, on one edge all layers are unconnected and on the third edge you can see three folds.

With your scissors you can now cut patterns into this triangle. Make sure that you cut through all eight layers at the same time. You should not cut those two edges completely which are made of connected layers of paper, otherwise the folded square will fall apart. You can cut anything you can think of into that triangle. For example triangles or squares, or even spirals and other patterns. The result might look like this:



4. Unfold the decorated triangles again and see what kind of artwork you have created! You can also stick tracing paper behind the pattern before you hang it on your window.
